Case Study

The picturesque Bayview area sits 40km north of Sydney's business district, giving the owner views across Pittwater towards one of many harbours surrounding the location.



Given the serene location and miles of unspoilt views across the bay, it made little sense to obscure those breathtaking with a display. This is where **Bluetone Systems Integration** chose to install our **PSE90** motorised wall mount to ensure the TV remains against the wall until it is required.

The discreet wall mounting solution ensures that the display compliments the aesthetic of the room, as opposed to dominating it. This installation shows that a display doesn't need to be the main feature within a space, but can instead transform a room to suit the user's needs.



Bluetone Systems Integration's clever socket placement and cable routing also offer a unique solution to cable management for all the display's wiring. Combining this practical and aesthetic socket placement with the **PSE90's** effortless cable management areas ensures that unsightly cables do not distract the viewer during operation, while remaining easily accessible for servicing and maintenance in the future. The custom sockets sit alongside the bracket within a recess to allow

the display to sit flush against the wall when it is not in use.



Powering the entire home behind the scenes is a Crestron system, which has been combined with touchscreens throughout the property to automate every aspect of the home, including, lighting and our **PSE90** mechanism.
